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### **SUPPLEMENTAL EMS PARAMEDIC JOB POSITION (\$12.75 /hr.)**

The primary function of the EMS Supplemental Paramedic is to respond to medical emergencies via the District ambulances. Supplemental Paramedics will also respond to other types of emergencies via the District ambulances, and act as support for things such as medical rehabilitation of crews at fires and hazmat incidents.

Individuals must possess Paramedic certification in the Nor-Cal EMS region, with all other certification required by Nor-Cal EMS, CPR Health Care Provider, and a CA ambulance driver's license. Applicants must be able to work all shifts including day or night / weekday and weekends, and be available for various work hours. Supplemental Paramedics normally are not to exceed more than 12 hours in a normal shift, and 36 hours per workweek. Hours are not normally to exceed 1,000 hours worked per fiscal year. This is a non-benefited position.
